What is Chlamydia?





How do I know if I have Chlamydia?

To find out if you have Chlamydia you need to take a swab from the lower vagina. A cotton wool bud is used to wipe the area.



- Make sure that you have filled in the form you may need help to do this
- 2. Peel off one of the numbered stickers and stick it to the container



- 3. Get into a comfortable position as if you were going to insert a tampon
- 4. Take out the cotton wool bud
- 5. Softly push the cotton wool bud a little way inside your vagina
- 6. Turn the swab round inside you for a few seconds
