# About Get It On

**Get It On** is a targeted scheme offered by YorSexual Health, designed to support professionals in promoting safer sex and sexual health services amongst their service users.

This scheme offers training and resources to equip professionals with the knowledge and confidence to:

- Signpost individuals to appropriate sexual health services
- Distribute condoms and promote safer sex
- Offer chlamydia screening kits and facilitate their return, helping to reduce rates of undiagnosed infection

Whether you work in education, youth services, healthcare, or community settings, **Get It On** provides practical tools and guidance to help you play a vital role in supporting sexual health and wellbeing. By signing up, you'll be joining a network of professionals across York and North Yorkshire who are committed to empowering individuals to take control of their sexual health in a safe, informed, and confidential way.



# Joining the Scheme



To join our Get It On scheme, visit our [registration form](#) by following the link or scanning the QR code.

We'll be in touch to arrange your training session. These are quarterly, via Microsoft Teams, however if you are a larger organisation with a number of staff, we could offer you a bespoke session.

# Training

Your training session will be delivered by our Community Outreach Worker, who is highly experienced in engaging individuals with sexual health services. **You must have an up to date DBS to complete the training.**

The session will cover topics that will support you in having meaningful conversations with your service users such as:

- Contraception
- Emergency Contraception
- STI, testing, and treatment
- PEP and PrEP (for HIV prevention)
- Sexual Assault
- Unplanned Pregnancy

We'll also cover topics to support you such as:

- Consent
- Safeguarding Guidelines

# What Next?

After you have completed your training, you'll receive your Get It On welcome pack. This includes:

- Certificate of Attendance
- Condom Ordering Link
- Chlamydia Kit Link
- Window Sticker
- Posters Link

You'll also be connected to our Specialist Community and Clinical Outreach (SCCOT) team, who will be on hand to provide support to you should you need it.

After 3 months, we'll ask you to complete your first quarterly report.

# Reporting

Each quarter, you'll be asked to complete a report on how the scheme has been working in your organisation.

We'll send you a reminder and the link to the form.

The report asks you for a narrative on your last quarter. We're keen to hear about your successes and challenges, how many condoms and kits you have given out, and the types of service user you are engaging with.

Our SCCOT team will analyse your report and will be able to offer you additional support if required.




# Ordering Supplies

When you've completed the training, you'll be able to order your condoms (we'll send you a unique log in) and chlamydia kits (using the form on the GIO page of our website)

Condoms and chlamydia testing kits come at a significant cost to our service. We respectfully ask that you are cautious with your ordering in the first instance, and ensure that you distribute in a meaningful way to avoid wastage.

High order and low return rates for our chlamydia testing kits may mean that you are unable to order in future without discussion and support.






# Safeguarding

Safeguarding is everyone's responsibility. Whenever you are giving out condoms or STI kits, you have a duty of care to ensure your service user:

- Has knowledge of consent, their rights, and their responsibilities
- Understands healthy relationships
- Is able to put a condom on correctly
- Is aware of where they can access sexual health services.

When working with young people under the age of 18, we'll ask you to complete a form for your records. This will be available in your welcome pack.
